**Location and Description**

This small, abandoned family cemetery is located within the historic Cadron Settlement Park. It contains the graves of the Stephen Harris family. It is approximately 32 feet square. The U. S. Corps of Engineers erected a 3-foot high treated Pinta post and double-rail fence to protect the site. When the Faulkner County Historical Society surveyed this burial ground in 1979, they described it, as follows: “The cemetery is in a fenced-in plot on the hill north of the main pavilion at the park.”

**History**

In addition to the Stephen Harris burial ground, the Conway Chamber of Commerce and the Faulkner County Historical Society have placed five memorial markers on the grounds of the park in cooperation with the U. S. Corps of Engineers. A federal historical marker was placed in 1936.
