

On Friday, July 26, 1822, MR. PETER LEFEVRE, aged about 36 years, died at his Pulaski County residence, located about eight miles below Little Rock. About a week before his death, a small red spot made its appearance on his right side, accompanied by some pain, which gradually became acute and extended to his head. After two or three days, it assumed a blackish appearance, when a mortification of the part took place, which resulted in his death. He was survived by his widow and five children.

On Friday, August 30, 1822, MRS. BLAIR died in Pulaski County, at an advanced age.

In the latter part of September of 1822, MISS NANCY BENTLEY, daughter of George Bentley, late of Virginia, died at Pecannerie.

In February of 1824, DR. R. H. FENNER died at Little Rock.

On May 28, 1824, ELIZA WHITE, wife of Thomas White, died at Pecannerie.

On September 25, 1824, WILLIAM LEWIS, son of Col. William Lewis, died at Pecannerie.

In January of 1825, MARK WESTLAND, a native of Austria, died at Crystal Hill.

In January of 1825, HIRAM GREEN died at Crystal Hill.

In February of 1825, JOSEPH BENTLEY, son of George Bentley, died at Pecannerie.

In August of 1825, SAMUEL FAULKNER, late of the Steamer Sparton, died at the home of James H. Martin, aged 30 years.
