July 8 - State of Arkansas vs. E. A. Hines, defaulting juror summoned in case of Calvin Coker vs. William C. Sullivan, and failed to appear. Ordered that attachment issue against him returnable tomorrow morning.

July 9 - Court adjourned.

July 10 - State of Arkansas vs. Thomas Kendrick, J. E. McDonald, Lafayette Draper and E. A. Hines, for contempt of court. Fines remitted, and case dismissed.

July 10 - State of Arkansas vs. E. A. Hines, for contempt of court. Case dismissed, attachment dismissed.

July 10 - State of Arkansas vs. William M. Gonge, for contempt of court. Summoned as juror in case of John Wassell vs. Martha F. Trapnall, and failed to appear. Ordered that attachment issue against him, returnable on Monday next, to show cause why he should not be fined.

July 11 - Court adjourned until Monday morning.

July 13 - State of Arkansas vs. James A. Kinnear, for contempt of court, defaulting juror in case of M. F. Trapnall vs. Stillwell and Wassell. \$10.00 fine remitted, defendant discharged.

July 13 - State of Arkansas vs. William M. Gonge, for contempt of court. Defendant discharged, attachment dismissed.

July 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 - Court adjourned.

July 20 - State of Arkansas vs. Calvin Nixon, on indictment for larceny. Account of Benjamin F. Danley, sheriff and jailor of Pulaski County, for \$13.00, for safe keeping and board of Calvin Nixon, and for committing and discharging Nixon from the county jail. Ordered allowed.

July 20 - State of Arkansas vs. William Bays. Costs of \$198.30 allowed and certified to Saline County, from where case was removed.

July 21 - State of Arkansas vs. Lorenzo Gibson, for contempt of court, defaulting witness in case of Patrick P. Burton vs. John Wassell. Ordered that attachment issue, returnable forthwith. Defendant appeared and was discharged, and attachment dismissed.

July 22 and 23 - Court adjourned.
