This Bible was published by the American Bible Society at New York in 1853, and was loaned to us by Mrs. Claude E. McCreight of Little Rock. The entries on the family record pages were made by Orville Jennings until his death, and after that probably by his widow and his son Chester.

In Washington, Hempstead Co. Arks., on Wednesday, the 8th day of October, A. D. 1851, by the Rev. Henry C. Thweatt, Orville Jennings, formerly of Leeds, Maine, to Miss Juliet Pauline Block, of the former place.

In Arkadelphia, Clark County, Arks., on Tuesday morning, May 1st, A. D. 1860, by the Rev. Saml. Wells, Orville Jennings of Washington Arks., to Miss Elizabeth Camp Denison, formerly of Sackett's Harbor, New York.

In Little Rock, Ark. on Feby 10th 1885 by the Rev. Wm. H. Vernor, Chester Jennings to Jean M. Vernor both of Little Rock, Ark.

BIRTHS

Born, on Monday, the 25th day of July, A. D. 1853, at Washington, Arks. Edwin Brittin Jennings, Eldest Child and son of Orville and Juliet P. Jennings.

Born, on Saturday, the 7th day of July, A. D. 1855; at Washington, Arks. Ernest, second child and son of Orville and Juliet P. Jennings.

Born, on Sunday, the 6th day of July, A. D. 1856, at Washington, Arks. Laura Ida, third child and daughter of Orville and Juliet P. Jennings.

Born, on Sunday, the 27th of September, A. D. 1857, at Washington, Arks. Chester, fourth child and son of Orville and Juliet P. Jennings.

Born, on Thursday, the 29th day of July A. D. 1858, at Washington, Arkansas, prematurely, of seven months gestation - a beautiful boy; whose birth caused his mother's death and who survived her only two days, I named him Julius, for his mother, fifth child of Orville and Juliet P. Jennings. (O. Jennings).

Born, at Leeds, Kennebec County, on the 14th day of January, A. D. 1825, Maine, Orville Jennings, son of Penez Smith Jennings and Joan Jennings, of said town of Leeds, and husband of Juliet P. Jennings, and subsequently husband of Elizabeth C. Jennings.

Born, at Washington, Hempstead County, Arkansas, on the 1st day of September A. D. 1830, Juliet Pauline Block, daughter of Abraham Block and Frances Isaacs Block, of said town of Washington, and wife of Orville Jennings.
