George W. Copp, Wakefield, New Hampshire, to Estate of Nathaniel Philbrook, Dr., August, 1819.

To a note delivered to you against John Copp, amount due on same about -----\$56.00

To a draft on William Lawyer, drawn by W.C. Frost-- 70.00

The following memorandum accompanied the above charge, in N. Philbrook's handwriting: "The above left for collection or get secured." William E. Woodruff, Adm.

Arkansas February 10th 1820 - Due Rufus P. Spalding Edq. or order Fifty dollars as a retaining fee in the case now pending between Amos Wheeler and others against William Russell on a certiorari from a Justice court, Witness my hand and seal.
