

SHOT WHILE PRAYING.

Henry Beacon Assassinated in a Church
at Brownsville, Pa.

Little Rock, Ark., July 31.—Last night, while a revival meeting was in progress at Brownsville, Crawford County, in the little village church, the services were brought to an abrupt end by the discharge of a Winchester, which resulted in the death of Henry Beacon, a young man who owns the largest general store in the north-western portion of Crawford County. The evangelist conducting the meeting was praying at the time the shot was fired, and young Larue has stated I hear a window in a supplicant attitude, his head, braced in his hands, resting upon the window sill. The bullet from the assassin's gun tore the top off Beacon's head. Nearly all the male inhabitants of the church went in search of the assassin and continued the hunt until morning without discovering any trace of the fugitive. The motive for the deed is a mystery.
