

Death of Arthur B. Crozier.

Arthur Bertram Crozier, 33 years old, a mechanical engineer with offices in the Commerce Building, died at 5:15 o'clock yesterday morning at his home, 3006 Park Avenue, of typhoid fever. He had been ill a month. Mr. Crozier was reared in Fayetteville, Ark., and graduated from the State University of Arkansas. In 1899 he came to Kansas City and entered the employ of the Schwarzschild & Sulzberger Packing Company. Later he was with Cudaby at Omaha. Then he opened an office here. He was a son of Rev. William Crozier, a Presbyterian minister of Fayetteville, Ark. He leaves, besides his widow, two daughters, Roberta and Jane, 5 and 2 years old. The funeral services will be held at 3 o'clock this afternoon at the home. The body will be sent to Lexington, Mo.
