

Arkansas Pioneer, 102, Dies in Fayetteville

FAYETTEVILLE, Ark., Aug. 29.—Mrs. Mary A. Schoolfield, 102, died at her home in Fayetteville Thursday. Mrs. Schoolfield was born near Pikeville, Tenn., March 1, 1829, the daughter of Charles and Mary Worthington Hutcheson, both members of pioneer Tennessee families. In 1849 she was married to Mr. R. E. Schoolfield and in 1851 they traveled on horseback across Tennessee into Arkansas.

Mrs. Schoolfield is survived by a daughter, Mrs. H. LeGate, of San Antonio and one son, R. E. Schoolfield of Wichita Falls, several grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
